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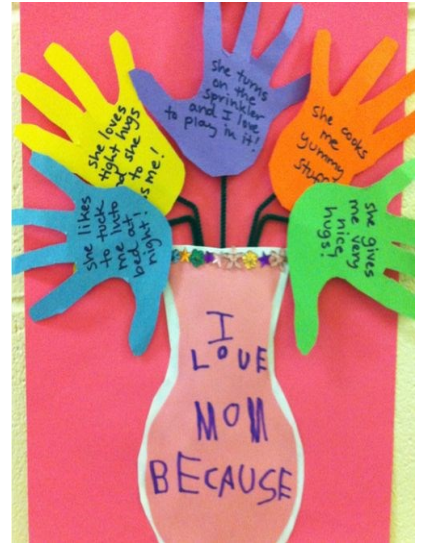
Mother's Day "I Love You" Craft

Directions:

Late Claim and Reimbursement Schedule

-You have until the 4th business day to turn in claims for them to be on time. Anything received after 4:30pm on that date will be marked late.

-Reimbursements are deposited on the first business day of the month. If the 1st falls on a weekend, reimbursements will be distributed on the next business day. Months this will apply are May, October, and Jan (2017).

**Please note that direct deposit payments are processed more quickly than checks so get signed up today.

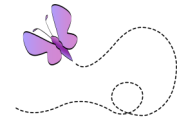

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Let's Cook—Healthy Baked Chicken Nuggets



Ingredients:

- 16 oz (2 large) skinless boneless chicken breasts, cut into even bit sized pieces
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt and black pepper, to taste
- 2 tsp olive oil
- 6 Tbsp whole wheat Italian seasoned breadcrumbs
- 2 Tbsp panko
- 2 Tbsp grated parmesan cheese



Directions:

- Preheat oven to 425*. Spray baking sheet with olive oil spray.
- Put the olive oil in one bowl & the breadcrumbs, panko & parmesan cheese in another.
- Season chicken with salt and pepper, then put in the bowl with the olive oil and mix well so the olive oil evenly coats all of the chicken.
- Put a few chunks of chicken at a time into the breadcrumb mixture to coat, then on the baking sheet. Lightly spray the top with olive oil spray then bake 8 – 10 minutes. Turn over then cook another 4 – 5 minutes or until cooked through.

Business Corner

Direct Deposit

If you need to change your direct deposit account information, an application for direct deposit form (along with a voided check or a statement containing the account number and the provider's name) must be turned into CMA no later than the first Friday of the month. You can print the application off of our website, www.cmutah.net/forms. When deposits are sent to closed accounts, CMA must wait until they bounce out of the provider's bank before issuing the provider another payment. Therefore, if deposit information is not given in time, it will result in a delay of the deposit. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the office. If you are not yet set up on direct deposit please do so as soon as possible.

Summer Day Care Hours

If your day care hours are changing for the summer months, let us know. Monitors do unannounced drop-in visits based on the hours providers write on their FDCH, and the meals claimed.

Please call the office if you are adjusting your day care hours.

Fire Extinguisher Requirements

CACFP guidelines mandate that all day care providers participating in the food program (*relative care AND state licensed*) must have a current tag on their fire extinguishers. Food program rules require tagged fire extinguishers even though state licensing no longer does. Please note that CMA monitors will be checking fire extinguishers for a current inspection tag.
